

Cosmetology Application Course 06781/06782 2017-2018

Course Description: The 1-year program satisfies 750 hours of the 1500-hour State of Illinois Cosmetology licensure requirements for students who are interested in pursuing a career in hair, nails and esthetics. High School District 214 will provide tuition costs for the first year of the 2-year program. Throughout the program, students are responsible for course materials and providing reliable transportation. In addition, tuition /fee costs for the 2nd year of the program after graduation. The Cosmetology training sites include Technology Campus of Lake County and Technology Center of Du Page. Students will have an option of selecting one of these sites which meets their scheduling and personal needs, and need to rank their preference. There are cost and program differences between the programs so careful review of information is recommended. Programs may include required attendance during evenings and non-attendance days, including Saturdays and summer and holiday breaks. Students enrolled in more than three courses during the school day may not be eligible for the program.
