**Agreement:**

- Specific details regarding each dual credit option are listed in the District 214 academic handbook, available at <http://www.d214.org/academics/academic-handbook/>.
- Students enrolled in College Composition (03291/03292) for dual credit must qualify according to Harper College’s prerequisite requirements. Harper’s current prerequisites require a student to meet ONE of the following criteria:
  - ACT English score of 19 or better AND ACT Reading score of 20 or better
  - SAT Evidence Based Reading & Writing score of 510 or better
  - Seven semester 3.0 out of 4.0 cumulative GPA
  - Harper writing proficiency test
- Students enrolled in College Mathematical Applications 101 (04971/04972), College Algebra (04401/04402), or Physical Science (05241/05242) must qualify according to Harper College’s prerequisite requirements. Harper’s current prerequisites requires a student to meet ONE of the following criteria:
  - ACT Math score of 22 or better
  - SAT Math 530 or better
  - Harper College MATH 080 placement exam qualifying score AND two semesters of High School Geometry with a C- or better
  - ALEKS score of 46 or better
- Students whose grades fall below a C could be in danger of impacting their future Financial Aid package.
- Students should see their counselor regarding additional forms and steps which may be necessary to complete enrollment in addition to details regarding obtaining post-secondary transcripts for dual credit courses.
- If students have questions about transferability with any of these courses, they should directly contact the college/university in which they are interested.
