

John Hersey High School Guest Application Form

The dance policy at John Hersey High School allows a student to bring one guest to a dance, providing that the following information is completed prior to the event. For the 2012 Spring Dance, this form must be completed by the JHHS Dean's office before purchasing a ticket, and turned in at the time of purchasing your ticket. No forms will be accepted in the Dean's Office after Thursday, March 8th.

A guest must be a minimum of a ninth grade student. The maximum age of a guest is 20 years old. A guest must present a valid high school ID to enter the dance, and a non-high school student must present a valid driver's license. **A photocopy of the appropriate identification must be attached to this application. FAXES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** A guest must have the appropriate picture ID available at all times on the night of the dance.

John Hersey High School **Policies and Procedures for Dances**

- **If you are inviting a non-JHHS student to the dance, you and your guest must complete a guest application form. These forms are available in the Main Office or the Attendance Office. You must have it approved by the Dean's office. Forms must be turned in when tickets are purchased.**
- **A JHHS student is allowed to bring one non-Hersey student as a guest.**
- **A guest must be a minimum of a high school student, but no older than 20 years old.**
- **Once approved, you must have the guest form with you in order to purchase tickets to the dance. ALL PERSONS BRINGING A GUEST TO THE DANCE MUST PURCHASE TICKETS IN ADVANCE OF THE DANCE. No guest will be able to purchase tickets the night of the dance.**
- **A JHHS student who brings a guest to the dance will be responsible to make sure that his/her guest follows all JHHS and District 214 rules regarding conduct at the dance.**
- **Students must arrive at the dance no later than one hour after the dance has officially begun. If a student arrives after this time, he/she will be subject to search and may be administered a breathalyzer test, or refused entry.**
- **Students are not allowed to bring backpacks, bags, glow sticks, canes, walking sticks, hats, etc, into the dance.**
- **Anyone attending the dance is expected to dress appropriately for the occasion. Young men must keep their shirts on throughout the dance. Garments that are see-through, cut low, or expose one's midriff are not acceptable. Undergarments must not be visible. Dress that is considered inappropriate by school personnel will result in the student being sent home. If you have questions regarding appropriate dress, please see the Deans for final approval.**
- **All school rules, as outlined in the student handbook, apply to anyone who attends the dance. Slam dancing, shoulder riding, mosh pits, inappropriate treatment of others, violent behavior, drug or alcohol use, smoking, are not permitted.**
