#9981/2 Education Academy

The Education Academy is a two credit, full year course open to highly motivated seniors from any District 214 High School, who are seriously interested in a career in education and ready for college level academic rigor. This program involves students working onsite in a classroom setting at a local school three days per week, from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. The remaining two days, students will participate in classroom activities at Rolling Meadows High School. Students will rotate through elementary, secondary school, special education and bilingual education classes for approximately ten weeks per rotation. Classroom assessment is based on tests, quizzes, papers, journals, discussions of professional research, lab practicals, presentations and group projects. Evaluations from onsite assignments are based on feedback from participating teachers.

Students must have excellent attendance, be highly motivated, hard working, able to participate in group activities, be leaders as well as followers and willing to spend 2 hours daily in this program.

Contact your school counselor or career advisor for an application. The application, letters of recommendation and a personal interview determine admittance to the program.
