

District 214 is a Redefining Ready School with the goal of graduating students who are college




Highlights of student experiences includes:

Of the 4-year college bound students 70% staved in Illinois. Of those students 50% attended an in-state public institution and 50% went to an in-state private institution.

School and Community

Elk Grove High School, home of the Grenadiers, is one of six, four-year comprehensive high schools in IL High School District 214. It includes portions of the villages of Elk Grove, Des Plaines, Mt. Prospect and Arlington Heights. Elk Grove has an ethnically diverse population made up of students that are 44% Latino, 40% White, 10% Asian, 2% Black and 3% Other. The devoted and professional staff of teachers. counselors, coaches and support staff at EG collaborate to provide a relevant, rigorous curriculum in a safe, supportive learning environment for about 2,000 students. EG's curricular program features a purposefully aligned, standards-based core course sequence coupled with a vast range of elective related to preparing students for a future in any of the 16 career clusters. Our focus is on developing students into academically successful, ethically prudent young adults.


+Dual Credit courses are identifiable on transcripts by course number. If a number begins with a 6 it is a dual credit course
