**Agreement:**

- Specific details regarding each dual credit option are listed in the District 214 academic handbook, available at <http://www.d214.org/academics/academic-handbook/>.
- Students must meet both college/university prerequisites and District 214 prerequisites in order to be eligible. Please check with your counselor to ensure all prerequisites are met.
- **Students whose grades fall below a C could be in danger of impacting their future Financial Aid package.**
- Students should see their counselor regarding additional forms and steps which may be necessary to complete enrollment. Students who fail to complete all necessary forms and applications may be ineligible to be enrolled in dual credit.
- Students are responsible for requesting and obtaining post-secondary transcripts for dual credit courses. Students should see their counselor for details.
- If students have questions about transferability with any of these courses, they should directly contact the college/university in which they are interested.
- Student’s dual credit enrollment is also subject to the college’s enrollment and withdrawal policies. Students who withdraw from course after designated drop period may risk receiving a ‘W’ or ‘F’ on college transcript.
- Some of District 214’s college/university partners charge fees associated with dual credit. These fees should be paid to High School District 214 in order to be rostered for dual credit. Fee information is show below.
