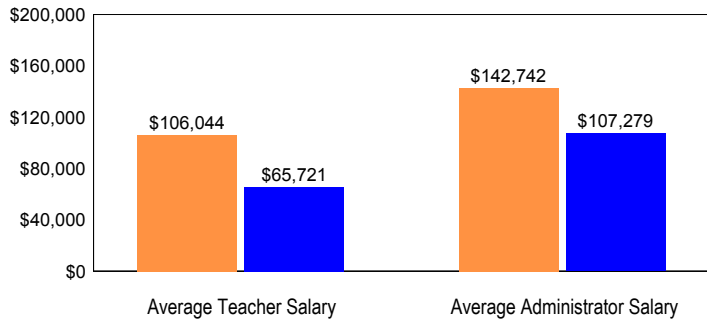

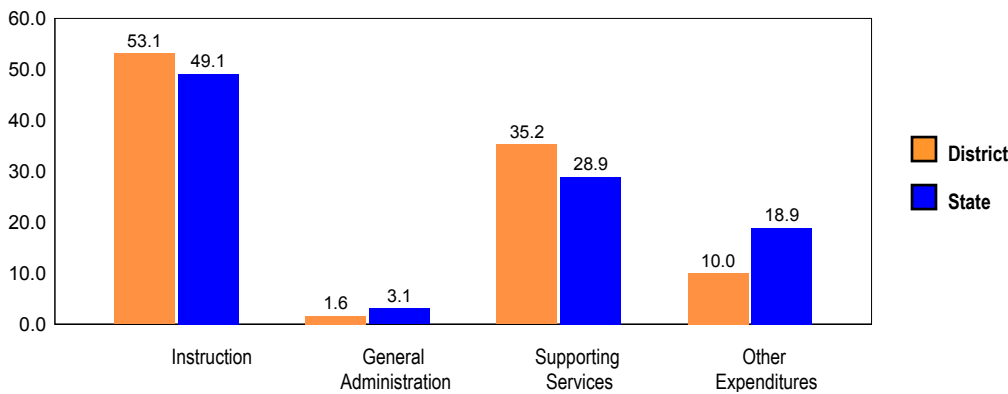
AVERAGE TEACHER/ADMINISTRATOR SALARIES
