



ATTENDANCE CONSEQUENCES/REFERRALS

Students are expected to maintain daily attendance at school especially on days of competition or performance. Failure to do so may result in ineligibility for participation. Class cutting or truancy may result in any of the following actions: detention, Saturday detention, lunch detention, in-school suspension, restorative practices, loss of privileges (i.e., parking, after school and co-curricular activities, off campus lunches, etc.), truancy referral, and/or parent/guardian conference. **Excessive class cuts can also be a violation of local city ordinances**.
