

## Access to Schoology for Parents


If you are a parent logging into Schoology using the parent code, please refer to the instructions below. (Schoology.com)


If you HAVE NOT signed in to Schoology before, you will have to create an account.

Step 1. Click on “Sign Up” in the top right hand corner.




\*\*\*\*Note: this is NOT the class code that the students use. This will give you VIEW ONLY privileges to the class.





On this page, click the tab in the top right hand corner. You will see your name as well as your student's name. Click on your student's name.




Step 5: Once you click on your student's name, you should be able to click on "Courses" at the top of the page, and a list of the student's courses will be available.

Click on the course you wish to view.




