As the weather warms, thoughts are drawn to the end of the year activities including Prom. We hope this event is a memorable and happy occasion for your family! We would like to remind each of our Prom attendees of the guidelines which are designed to ensure a pleasant and safe experience for all.

Prom is scheduled for May 03, 2025, at the **Lincolnshire Marriott** and runs from **7:00 pm until 11:30 PM**. As always, attendance will be taken, and the doors will open at 6:30 PM. If a student does not arrive at the venue by 7:45 PM, they will not be admitted in, and no refunds will be issued. Please ensure that your student has a ride promptly after the Prom ends at 11:30 PM.

All students and their possessions are subject to search upon entry. In the event that a student shows signs of ANY use of alcohol or drugs, the student's parents will be called to pick up their child. A school drug and alcohol conference will be scheduled, severe disciplinary consequences will be determined, and a police referral will be made. Also, Prom is tobacco free, regardless of age. Violation by a senior could endanger graduation. Finally, we expect that all attendees will behave appropriately, or they will be asked to leave, and their parents will be called. Students with outstanding detentions will be denied entrance, regardless if tickets were purchased, and no refunds will be issued.



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
