Families must complete the registration process to attend the first day of school on August 13, 2025.

<u>Additional documentation</u> might be required to process your registration; please have one of the following original documents ready to upload when you begin the process:

- Current utility bill (gas, water or electric) in the name of a parent/legal guardian
- Current lease or mortgage in the name of parent/legal guardian
- Current property tax bill in the name of parent/legal guardian

FRESHMAN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS

All freshman and transfer students must provide their original birth certificate.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

SENIORS: All students entering 12th grade must submit proof of an up-to-date meningococcal vaccination to the nurse's office prior to attending school.

FRESHMAN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS: All freshman and transfer students must submit current school physical with record of up-to-date immunizations to the nurse's office prior to attending school. All 9th grade students must submit a <u>State of Illinois</u> <u>Proof of School Dental Examination Form</u> that is dated on or after November 15th, 2024.
