- We are launching an Attendance Campaign because research shows and we know that good attendance is essential for academic success.
- We want every Wildcat to know that attendance matters and that it is an **expectation** and **responsibility** at WHS.
- Attendance will be a school-wide priority.
- We need every student here every day and on time.

Attendance Campaign

Did you know that...

- Missing 10% (just 2 days each month), excused or unexcused, can drastically affect a student's academic success.
- Students have 99% chance of passing a class if they miss fewer than 5 times.
- Students who attend 95% or their classes are more likely to earn a B or higher
- Attendance is an important life skill that will help your student be successful at Wheeling High School and beyond.

Attendance Campaign

We have always counted on you to be that support at home. Here's how you can help:

- Help your student get to school on time and make school attendance a priority
 - Students should be in class, in their seats, by 8:30am
- Review monthly postcards
- Read Quarterly Newsletter Article - mailed and can also be found on PARENT tab

- We're here to help with attendance!
 - Counselor, teacher, nurse, case manager, or Division Head for Student Success, Safety and Wellness.

Cell Phones

District-wide expectations:

- The use of cell phones and other electronic devices is **prohibited** in academic spaces. Cell phones must be **put away and unused during instructional time**.
- Cell phones must be turned off or silenced during instructional time unless (a) the teacher grants permission for them to be used; (b) the use of the device is provided for in a student's IEP, 504, or health plan; or (c) the device is needed during an emergency.
- Proper use of cell phones will be permitted in common areas such as the cafeteria, hallways, and media center.
- Cell phones may not be used in any manner that will cause disruption to the educational environment or will otherwise violate student conduct rules.

DHSSSW (Dean) Expectations

Start of Day/End of Day

- Students need to be in class, in their seats, by 8:30 am
 - Students may arrive early and eat breakfast or hang out with friends in the cafeteria before school
- Dismissal is at 3:00 pm
 - All students need to exit the building at 3:04 pm unless they have an after school sport/club or have for academic purposes.
 - Busses leave promptly at 3:09 - don't be late!

All students need to have their School ID

- IDs are scanned as students come into the building, as they leave for lunch periods, and in other areas of the building.

Student and visitor ENTRANCES and EXITS

- Main Front Entrance (Door 1) and Main Back Entrance (Door 29) only.

Food Delivery

- No food deliveries will be accepted.

Open Lunch

- Freshman can earn open lunch for their sophomore year

Failure to follow any of the above expectations may result in a referral to the DHSSSW (Dean). Students may be issued a restorative and/or punitive response to their behavior. Students may serve detentions in the morning (7:45 - 8:20), during their assigned lunch period, after school (3:10pm - 4:45pm), or Saturdays (8:00am - 12:00 pm).

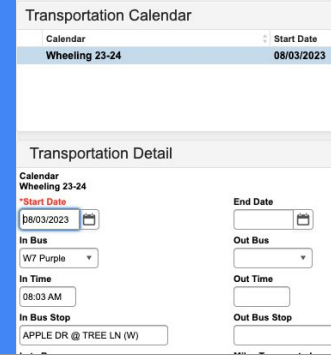

- Students that live outside a mile and a half will be provided with a bus route
 - Parent drop off and pick up is at the front of WH
 - Bus drop off and pick up is at the back of the building
 - Students will need to use their IDs to scan on and off the bus
 - Bus stops are pre-arranged by Grand Prairie Transportation

School Safety

Seguridad en la Escuela

- All doors are locked when entering WHS
 - Students must scan into the building at all times entering or leaving the building
 - All visitors must provide a valid ID to enter the building
 - ID is scanned and checked if they are on a list that would prevent their entry
 - Wheeling High School has a sophisticated camera system that allows us to keep the building safe during and outside of the school day
 - We have two Police Liaison Officer on staff at WHS during the entire school day. Also, members of the the Wheeling Police Department do occasional school visits and walk the school
 - WHS works in conjunction with the Wheeling and other law enforcement agencies to ensure the safety of our students and staff.
- Todas las puertas están cerradas con llave cuando entras a WHS
 - Estudiantes deben de escanear sus IDs al entrar o salir al edificio
 - Todos que visitan tienen que enseñar un ID valido para entrar a la escuela
 - ID escaneado y chequeado para ver si están en una lista que previene que entren
 - Wheeling High School tiene un sistema sofisticado de cámaras que mantienen al edificio seguro durante y después del día escolar
 - Tenemos un intermediario de la Policía en WHS durante el día escolar. También miembros del departamento de policías de Wheeling hacen visitas y caminan la escuela
 - WHS trabaja con las agencias de Wheeling para reforzar la seguridad de nuestros estudiantes y empleados.
