He participated in the National Team Selection Camp in Southern California last spring which is the Olympic Development Program for 18u. In the summer of 2023, Gavin traveled overseas to train with a select team and with 5 time Olympic water polo player and 2008 Olympic Silver medalist, Tony Azevedo. Gavin is graduating in December, and in January will travel to Dallas for the Regional Olympic Development Tournament. In March, he will return to Chicago for the National Olympic Development Tournament. Finally, in the spring of 2024, he will travel again with Tony and other select athletes to play in Italy. He has been named as a USA Water Polo Academic All American.
