#### BASIC ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE YES! STUDENT PARTICIPANT

- Be enrolled in a District 214 High School.
- Be between 15 and 18 years of age.
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average.
- Maintain a legal attendance rate.
- Have the ability to read, write and comprehend direction and training material in English or have interpretation capabilities.
