The Student and Parent/Guardian agree to abide by the following terms and conditions during the period of time the equipment is loaned:

- 1. Student and Parent/Guardian shall exercise reasonable care in the use of each item and preserve it in a careful and proper manner. The Parent/Guardian of the Student agree that he/she will be responsible for the repair or replacement of any lost, stolen or damaged equipment at the prevailing rate for materials and labor. Charges will be made to the Parent/Guardian for the repair or replacement of any lost or damaged equipment. Parent/Guardian agrees to pay such charges upon receipt of invoice from Township High School District 214.
- 2. Any maintenance or repair service will be performed by the District.
- 3. The Student shall not modify or alter the operating system on any device
- 4. Student and Parent/Guardian shall be responsible for the pick-up and return to the high school of said equipment at the specified times.
- 5. Student and Parent/Guardian agree that the loaned equipment will only be used by the Student.
- 6. Title to the equipment shall remain with Township High School District 214 and nothing herein shall be construed vesting in the Student or Parent/Guardian any right of property.
- 7. Periodically apps and websites utilized for classroom instruction require students to confirm they are 17 or 18 years of age in order to download or register. These include some course textbooks and other apps web browsers that teachers request to be downloaded for class use. Parent/Guardian agrees to the student's use of these apps.
