

## Snapshot: STUDENT SERVICES

#### **Post Secondary**

Thanks to 82 amazing JHHS staff members we broke the **College Essay-palooza** record with 245 college essays sessions completed!

The **Class of 2024** has been busy applying to college, and through Common App alone, seniors submitted 2,183 applications by the end of the day on November 1st – including 222 On November 1st (10%!). To compare, the Class of 2023 submitted 1,764 through November 1st.

We hosted **116 college rep visits** this fall with 228 unique students attending! This spring we will introduce themed "mini panels" for college rep visits to give students an opportunity to hear from three different schools at once on a variety of topics.

#### **Student Success Coach**

- 31 interns successfully completed the fall internship program.
- Over 200 students applied to be a part of the Spring cohort.







#### **Student Services Groups**

- 15 Student Services Groups were run during 1st semester (with a projected 2-3 more groups to run 2nd semester).
- 22 Student Service staff ran groups.
- 39 Students were referred by JHHS staff and 5 students were self referred.
- 163 Students were serviced in groups total during 1st semester.
- Groups were: Career Search & Investigation, Check & Connect, Coping Skills, Executive Functioning, Healthy Decison Making, Managing Anxiety, Physical and Mental Wellness, Rememberance with Honor (Grief), Trailblazers (1st Generation) & Voces.
